A Contract Performance Notice (CPN) was issued in 2019 for Children in Care services delivered under the Children's Community Health Partnership Contract. We do not hold information on contracting arrangements with this provider prior to this. Clinical Partners: contract start date of 1st December 2024. CYP: The Sirona contract began on 1st April 2017 Clinical partners: contract start date of 1st December 2024
3. Has the contract ever been issued with a performance notice?	Adults: The AWP ADHD service was issued with a CPN in 2019. No CPN has been issued in respect of the contract with Clinical Partners. CYP: No CPN has been issued for delivery of Neurodiversity services.
4. What is the Annual Contract Value of the contract?	Adults: Adult Neurodiversity Services are part of a block contract with AWP and as such it is not possible to provide an annual contract value for these services.
