2. What cross-system learning was identified through PSIRF that relates to the care of learning disabled and/or autistic people in 2024-25?	As above, cross system learning has been identified following LeDeR reviews, but this is separate to PSIRF. Once the 2024/25 LeDeR report is published cross system including individual organisational learning and quality improvement initiatives can be found in this report.
