QUESTION	RESPONSE
1. How much Section 106 or CIL funding is currently held unspent by the ICB?	The ICB does not hold any unspent Section 106 or CIL funding. ICBs do not have the technical authority to hold or transact capital funding directly.
2. How much Section 106 funding was transferred from local authorities to the ICB in a) 2024/25, b) 2023/24, and c) 2022/23?	ICBs do not have the technical authority to transact capital funding directly.
3. How much CIL funding was transferred from local authorities to the ICB in a) 2024/2, b) 2023/24, and c) 2022/23?	ICBs do not have the technical authority to transact capital funding directly.
4. How much Section 106 funding did the ICB <i>request</i> to be transferred from local authorities in a) 2024/25, b) 2023/24, and c) 2022/23?	Section 106 funding is secured through the planning process, based on representations made during consultation on planning applications. The ICB does not make separate requests outside of the planning process to draw down Section 106 funding from local authorities.

5. How much Community Infrastructure Levy (CIL) funding did the ICB <i>request</i> to be transferred from local authorities in a) 2024/25, b) 2023/24, and c) 2022/23?	Local authorities are responsible for allocating CIL funding to infrastructure projects. The ICB has not made any formal requests for CIL funding during these periods.
6. Since April 1, 2022, how many times have local authorities declined the ICB's requests for the transfer of developer contributions (Section 106 or CIL funds)?	Not applicable.
7. For each case where a local authority declined a request for developer contributions since April 1, 2022, please provide a) the reason for the refusal and b) the amount of money requested.	Not applicable. The ICB makes representations for developer contributions through the planning consultation process. It does not request funding from general Council-held Section 106 or CIL pots.
8. Has the ICB ever reallocated any Section 106 or CIL funds originally designated for one project to another project? If so, please provide details of the amounts and reasons.	No. All Section 106 funding allocated to projects within the ICB area have been used for the projects to which it was originally designated.
